



Player Code of Conduct

As a player selected to represent **Ottawa Islamic Soccer League**, you will be judged based on your performance both on and off the field. Your personal conduct, whether in competition or in other situations, reflects upon your team's image. It is your responsibility to safeguard the reputation and pride of the club.

Player Guidelines

1. **Appropriate Attire:**
Players are expected to wear the appropriate attire whenever representing the club. Your conduct should always reflect credit upon **Ottawa Islamic Soccer League**.
2. **Respect for Others:**
Show respect and consideration towards the public, volunteers, and coaches involved in any club event. Your behavior should be positive and professional at all times.
3. **Be a Gracious Guest:**
Players are reminded that, in most cases, they are guests and should always conduct themselves with respect for others, especially when at external facilities or events.
4. **Handshake Etiquette:**
Always shake hands with all academy staff you encounter. This is a simple but important gesture of respect.
5. **Zero Tolerance Policy:**
The use of tobacco, consumption or possession of alcohol, and illegal substances will not be tolerated. **Ottawa Islamic Soccer League** maintains a strict zero-tolerance policy.
6. **Commitment to Training:**
Players agree to follow the home technical training program and strength program as prescribed by the coaching staff to enhance their development.

8. **Priority of Education:**

Players are expected to maintain a high standard in school. Education comes first before soccer, and players will be required to submit their report cards at three reporting periods during the school year.
