

Player Uniform Policy

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that teams representing **Ottawa Islamic Soccer League** in area soccer leagues, tournaments, and in-house programs are outfitted appropriately.

1. Uniform Provision and Design

- Ottawa Islamic Soccer League is committed to providing serviceable and attractive uniform kits consistent with club branding for all representative and competitive players.
- This policy outlines the uniform kits provided to players, security deposits, uniform distribution to teams, uniform returns, and more.

2. Uniform Colors

- Competitive team uniforms depends on which team your child is on.
- Recreational team uniforms depends on which team your child is on.
- All jerseys will feature the Ottawa Islamic Soccer League logo and a unique team number on the back.

3. Mandatory Uniform Items

• Jersey (long sleeve for girls and short sleeve for boys), pants/shorts (pants for girls and shorts for boys) and socks.

4. Coach Attire

- Coaches will be issued a club-branded collar shirt (1 per team for both Recreational and Competitive teams), which must be worn at all events where the coach is representing Ottawa Islamic Soccer League, including league games and tournaments.
- Additional polo shirts can be purchased through the Club Administrator.

5. Uniform Compliance

- Players who arrive at the field not wearing the proper attire will not be permitted to participate until they are in full attire.
- **Uniforms should not be worn to practices** to maintain their quality and condition. Practice jerseys are provided at the beggining of every season.

6. Uniform Distribution and Contact

- The Club Administrator will be the point of contact for all uniform-related issues.
- The Club Uniform/Equipment Director will distribute all uniforms/equipment to the teams.

7. Training Gear

- Every player is required to purchase the following training gear:
 - o 1 pair of socks
 - o 1 jersey
 - 1 pair of pant/shorts
- If player is registered for weekly training session, they will be given:
 - 1 practice jersey
 - o 1 ball
- Players are responsible for replacing any damaged or outgrown items.

8. Uniform Issuance and Return

- Youth (U4 to U5) players will be provided with:
 - 1 pair of shorts
 - o 1 pair of socks
 - o 1 Game Jersey.
- Youth (U6-U16) players will be provided with:
 - 1 pair of shorts/pants
 - 1 pair of socks
 - o 1 Game jersey.
- Adult Recreational players will be loaned:
 - 1 Recreational jersey (shorts and socks are available for purchase via the club store).

10. Uniform Care Instructions

Uniform Do's:

- Use only **mild detergents** (pH under 10).
- o Launder soiled uniforms immediately following the care labels.
- o Store uniforms in a **cool, dry area**, away from sunlight and fluorescent light.
- Air dry uniforms flat or tumble dry on low heat.

Uniform Don'ts:

- Do not wash in water hotter than 110°F.
- Do not wash colors with whites.
- Do not use bleach.
- o Do not store soiled or damp garments together.
- Do not dry garments on high heat.
- o Do not iron or press uniforms.

11. Failure to Comply

- Reports of uniform policy violations will be forwarded to the Directors of Competitive or Recreational Teams for investigation.
- Teams failing to comply may face penalties, including suspension from the club.

12. Uniform Order Availability

• Extra socks and shorts can be ordered through the **Club Store**.

This **Player Uniform Policy** ensures that all players maintain the highest standards of attire and professionalism while representing the **Ottawa Islamic Soccer League** in all soccer-related activities.
